Ekonomie, stygende brandstof- en voedselpryse:

Dr. Willie Cilliers gesels met Richard Shumi, mede-direkteur van die AHi.

Die ekonomie, die stygende brandstofpryse en voedselpryse, asook 'n duurder lewenskoste.

Dit is van die onderwerpe waaroor dr. Willie Cilliers, uitvoerende direkteur van die AHi, in die jongste radio-gesprek op Eden FM gesels.

"Alles dui daarop dat die prys van petrol en diesel tussen R3 en R4 per liter sal styg," sê dr. Willie Cilliers. "Dit is 'n geweldige styging en ons weet dit loop hand-aan-hand met vervoerkostes en op die ou einde lewenskostes wat styg. Op die uit einde sal die geld van die gebruiker verhaal word, indien die vervoerkostes om produkte by die eindverbruiker te kry, styg."

In die onderhoud praat dr. Willie met Richard oor die hoe gemeenskappe kan hande vat om dié probleme te hanteer. Hulle praat veral oor voedselsekerheid, hongersnood en die AHi se Red 10-dorp-projek.

Parliament to debate SA's record petrol price hikes



Parliament will hold a debate on South Africa's record petrol price increases following an official request by the opposition Democratic Alliance.

While a date and time for the debate have not been set, the discussions are set to focus on the 1 June petrol price hike which could see the cost of petrol increase by close to R4/litre.

DA leader John Steenhuisen has warned that the government will need to intervene ahead of the increase or risk further civil unrest.

"If we do not stop this fuel price increase, millions more people will fall into poverty, children will be stunted, people will starve, businesses will go bankrupt, jobs will be lost and mass riots could be sparked, such as in Sri Lanka last month in response to fuel price hikes there."

Home Affairs minister Aaron Motsoaledi has announced a complete revamp of his department's systems in a move to cut down on long queues.

Presenting his departmental budget speech on Tuesday (24 May), Motsoaledi said that much of the work and resources are focused on the 'original sin' of his department – system downtime.

"It is painful and generates a lot of anger to visit a Home Affairs office very early in the morning and just stand there and wait for hours on end because all systems are down. It is very frustrating to say the least.

South Africa faces 16% petrol price jump in June





South Africans face record high petrol prices in June as a subsidy to help motorists counter the impact of high crude costs exacerbated by Russia's invasion of Ukraine comes to an end.

With a weighting of almost 5% in South Africa's inflation basket, the expected jump in pump costs is likely to push the gauge above the central bank's target range and spur price hikes across the economy. The government reduced the levy on fuel by 40% in April and May, helping to keep a lid on prices.

Hermanus is, according to the report, the fastest growing South African town for high-net-worth individuals. A large number of wealthy Cape Town, Pretoria and Johannesburg residents have relocated to Hermanus over the past ten years.



SA's smaller airports are recovering quicker





South Africa's regional airports are recovering quicker than their bigger counterparts as domestic travellers return to the skies while the lingering effects of the Covid-19 pandemic subdue international arrivals.

Travel to and from South Africa has been slow to recover after two years of disrupted flight schedules, border closures, and strict entry rules brought about by the Covid-19 pandemic. South Africa's international airports have been hardest hit, although some are recovering at a quicker rate than others.

This city is winning the race to get off Eskom's grid





Ekurhuleni, the industrial hub of more than three million people to the east of Johannesburg, may have a head start in the race between South African cities to buy their own power to alleviate crippling outages imposed by the national utility.

A program to procure as much as 700 megawatts of electricity that began in 2016 is coming to fruition, with one funder saying a project to build a 41-megawatt solar plant at a cost of about R1 billion (\$64 million) will begin by the end of this year.

In kort kom dit daarop neer dat die mens die natuur verwaarloos en dat hy dié verwaarlozing ter wille van sy voortbestaan moet omkeer en moet probeer om die land weer in sy paradyslike staat te herstel. Die opdrag is helder en duidelik '...na die 'ewebeeld van die Tuin.'

How to start your own business:

1. Go online to the website of CIPC and register a new company for R175. Registration is R125 and the name is R50.
2. Go to SARS, do a tax clearance for free (book an appointment to avoid waiting in line).
3. Open a business bank account. Most banks have “starter” accounts with monthly fees less than R500.
4. Go to your nearest Seda, ask them to do a business plan for you, for free - Plus other training that might be relevant to your field.
5. Go online, register on the CSD, for free.
6. Go to your municipality and ask them to register you on their database as a supplier, for free.
7. Go to your nearest NYDA, attend their financial management short course for a minimum of 5 weeks (once a week), for free.
8. Apply for the NYDA funding for free. They can give you equipment for up to R50 000.

You don't pay it back.

9. Hire people and register for COIDA, Letter of good standing at the Department of Labour.

10. Professionalize your business with: Logos, letterhead, business email, website, landline.
